

The Chattanooga Metropolitan Airport Authority is seeking a qualified individual to fill the position of Airport Police Officer. General duties include:

1. Law Enforcement/Security Duties

Related duties include: civil aviation security; general law enforcement; public safety dispatch; traffic control and enforcement; physical property security; operating and maintaining police equipment; patrols airport and responds to calls, insuring enforcement of all applicable Airport Authority rules and regulations and state, federal and local laws. Investigates, apprehends and arrests when necessary.

Starting Salary: \$29,042.58 per year

In accordance with TCA 38-8-106 applicants must:

- (1) Be at least eighteen (18) years of age;
- (2) Be a citizen of the United States;
- (3) Be a high school graduate or possess equivalency;
- (4) Not have been convicted of or pleaded guilty to or entered a plea of nolo contendere to any felony charge or to any violation of any federal or state laws or city ordinances relating to force, violence, theft, dishonesty, gambling, liquor, or controlled substances;
- (5) Not have been released or discharged under any other than honorable discharge from any of the armed forces of the United States;
- (6) Have such person's fingerprints on file with the Tennessee bureau of investigation;
- (7) Have passed a physical examination by a licensed physician;
- (8) Have a good moral character as determined by a thorough investigation conducted by the employing agency; and
- (9) Be free of all apparent mental disorders as described in the Diagnostic American Psychiatric Association. An applicant must be certified as meeting these criteria by a qualified professional in the psychiatric or psychological field.

Also, in accordance with TCA 38-8-109 applicants must:

- (A) Certified by the Tennessee Peace Officer Standards and Training Commission; as a law enforcement officer.
- (B) Successfully pass a physical fitness assessment; an extensive background investigation; an oral interview; a comprehensive medical examination by a physician (chosen by the airport) which includes drug and alcohol screening;
- (C) Possess and maintain a valid driver's license;
- (D) Have weight in relation to height and body frame of such proportions as to fall within general recognized healthy norms;
- (E) Have accurate eyesight (20/20 Corrected) with normal color perception;
- (F) A written test may be included.
